Specsavers is offering a three-year scholarship to one (1) individual accepted into Year One of the NAIT Optical Sciences Eyeglasses Program for the Fall of 2024.

This scholarship will cover the four (4) semester Eyeglasses Program, the two (2) semester Contact Lens Program, and associated tuition fees and textbooks.



Elizibility Criteria

- Applicants must apply and be accepted into Year One of the <u>NAIT/OAC Optical Sciences</u> <u>Eyeglasses Program</u> for the Fall 2024 intake
- Applicants must be enrolling in a full semester of courses for the Fall 2024 intake
- Applicants must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident of Canada, and reside within Canada, outside of the province of Alberta and the Territories (therefore, designated a NAIT/OAC student).
- Applicants are <u>not</u> required to be employed by Specsavers



The scholarship application submission process is completed online.

Along with providing basic contact information during the online submission process, scholarship applicants are required to submit answers to the following questions:

- Using 200 words or less, describe which Specsavers frame best matches your personality and why? (visit: https://www.specsavers.ca/glasses/all-glasses)
- ❖ At Specsavers, our values are what we stand for, and they are caring for one another, doing the right thing, and delivering on our promise. Using 200 words or less, describe which one of these values resonates with you most and how have you demonstrated this.
- How would you improve access to expert eye and vision care and is there a vulnerable population that you feel needs attention? Please explain in 200 words or less.

To submit your answers to the above questions during the online submission process, you must upload a PDF document that contains your answers. If your answers exceed the maximum number of words as outlined above, your submission will be invalid and not considered for the scholarship.



The final deadline for scholarship submissions is 11:59 PM Central Time on Thursday, August 8th, 2024.



Selection Process

All scholarship submissions will be reviewed by a panel of individuals from Specsavers and the OAC.

The selection process will be complete by August 16th, 2024.

The chosen recipient of the Specsavers Scholarship will be contacted and announced by Monday, August 19th, 2024.

Recipient Responsibilities

The scholarship recipient will be expected to meet the following responsibilities during their three (3) year scholarship:

- ❖ Maintain a passing grade in all courses to maintain the scholarship for all three (3) years.
- ❖ Be an upstanding community citizen and reflect the professional spirit of the OAC to maintain the scholarship for all three (3) years.
